Amtrak to Resume Weekend Passenger Service Through San Clemente

As the work to stabilize the railway in south San Clemente continues, commuter train service aboard the Amtrak Pacific Surfliner is **scheduled to resume weekend service between Orange County and San Diego starting on Feb. 4**, Amtrak announced this week.

Passenger rail operations between the Laguna Niguel/Mission Viejo Station and Oceanside have been suspended since Sept. 30, a result of movement on the track following the heavy rains that battered Southern California last fall.

Oceanside continues search for sand, downplays possibility of groins

Oceanside has approved the next phase of its sand restoration and retention project at a cost of \$2.6 million, though city officials downplayed the possibility of an earlier proposal to build rock groins on the beach.

“We are very sensitive to the issue of groins,” City Manager Jonathan Borrego said at Wednesday’s Oceanside City Council meeting. “It is a little disheartening to hear members of the public keep portraying this as a groin project. **The idea is to step back and look at more innovative solutions.**”
