## Oceanside Native wins World Surf League

Teenage sensation, Caitlin Simmers, became the youngest ever world surfing champion after winning the World Surf League (WSL) finals in Southern California!

Simmers, from Oceanside near the finals venue of Lower Trestles, is just 18 and on only her second year on the professional world tour. Her win over Florida's 2023 world champion and Paris Olympics gold medallist Caroline Marks was the first world title for California in more than 30 years.

Caitlin, the top seed for the one-day, winner-takes-all finals for the top five surfers, got off to a strong start in their best of three finals, scoring two excellent 8-point plus rides.
